The **Equatorial Guinea Assemblies of God**, lead by General Superintendent Sebastian Obiang Obeso, is trusting God for powerful and sustained outpouring of the Holy Spirit on their church in preparation for the greatest missionary and evangelistic outreach in their history. During the next three weeks pastors, Bible school students, and key lay leaders will be gathering in three strategic Holy Spirit Conferences in their country (see map below). These conferences will be conducted in cooperation with the **Acts in Africa Initiative**, a ministry within the Assemblies of God, Africa, whose mandate is to encourage Pentecostal revival in the African church. In these conferences delegates will receive training and inspiration concerning the work of the Holy Spirit in missions, intercede for a powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the church in Africa, strategize as to how to bring Pentecostal revival to their own churches and lives, and personally experience the power of Pentecost. The goal is to launch a powerful evangelistic and church planting movement with thousands finding Christ as Savior.
